The most crucial points of a child's schooling are Years 4/5, and Years 9/10/11.

Years 4/5 is the time for students' preparation for 11 plus examinations for grammar schools, or Common entrance/scholarship examinations. Years 10/11 is the time students prepare for 10, or 11 GCSE subjects.

If your child is *currently* attending a primary or prep school that does not test children for Verbal and Non-verbal reasoning, then this is a **golden opportunity**. Parents involved in transfer to secondary school for the first time find this very beneficial. All children take mock exams and are advised and assisted to overcome their weaknesses. Pupils taking Grammar/Independent, SATs tests are adequately supported. Parents will meet other parents whose children were successful in previous years' examination during special seminars.
